10. New Business:

A. Approval of Oak Ridge, Phase II, Section B Final Plat

Staff recommends final plat approval of Oak Ridge, Phase II, Section B. This development consists of 12 residential lots ranging in size from 43,017 to 66,760 square feet and is located off of Mill Pond Road in Newland Township. The site is zoned R-25A, Residential and all of the required improvements have been installed according to the approved Preliminary Plat and the Pasquotank County Subdivision Ordinance.

B. <u>Consideration of Petition for Addition of Roads in Oak Ridge Subdivision to the</u> State System for Maintenance

Enclosed is a petition from the developer of Oak Ridge Subdivision requesting the addition of Woodlee Dr. and Fannie Dr. to the State System. The length of each road and the number of occupied homes is listed on the petition beside the road names.

If the Board recommends approval of the road additions, it will need to adopt a resolution requesting that the Department of Transportation determine whether the roads meet DOT's requirements for addition to the state system.
