 - A. Public Hearing on Amendments to the Animal Control Ordinance
 The Special Projects Committee has recommended a series of animal welfare amendments to the County Animal Control Ordinance. The recommended provisions address items such as food, water, shelter and tethering. A couple of provisions, such as cruelty and abandonment, already exist in some form in the current ordinance but updated versions are being proposed. The Special Projects Committee also recommended revising the county's "dangerous dog" ordinance but that will be on a later agenda.

A public hearing is not required for this type of ordinance amendment but the county typically has one anyway. The amendments need a unanimous vote of the full board to be passed at the first meeting presented. If there is not a unanimous vote of the full board at the first meeting presented the amendments must be placed on the next agenda and only have to receive a simple majority to pass. Attached is a copy of the proposed amendments.

- B. Public Hearing on Solar Farm Moratorium

 Staff has recommended and the board has given tentative approval for a sixty (60) day moratorium on all new solar farm applications. It is anticipated staff will be bringing the Planning Board and Board of Commissioners recommended zoning text amendments to the county solar farm regulations during this sixty (60) day period. E. <u>Adoption of Resolution Levying An Additional One-Quarter Cent (1/4¢) County Sales and Use Tax</u>

The Board directed the Pasquotank County Board of Elections to conduct an advisory referendum on the question of whether to levy the one-quarter cent county sales and use tax in the county on the May 8th ballot. The referendum passed and the Board has provided the required 10 days public notice of its intent to consider the attached resolution to levy the tax. After the Board adopts the resolution, it must send a certified copy of the resolution along with a certified copy of the election results of the referendum to the Department of Revenue.
