D. Approval of Debris Monitoring Contract Extension

The Finance Committee has recommended approval of a one-year extension of the debris monitoring contract with Tetra Tech, with an increase of 9.2% in the hourly rates for staff due to inflation.

E. Resolution of Support for Grant to the Food Bank of the Albemarle

Jon Hawley, Elizabeth City's Grant Administrator, is requesting the Board approve the attached resolution of support for a potential grant to the Food Bank of the Albemarle. The funding would be reallocated from an existing CDBG the City received in late 2020. The City and the Albemarle Area United Way applied to NC Commerce for CDBG-CV funding to establish the Coronavirus Care Collaborative program in partnership with United Way. Mr. Hawley said they have less than a year left on the grant, and AAUW and himself project they will not exhaust all of the grant funds. They would like to disburse the unused funds to the Food Bank. I recommended approval of the request.
